At www.blackinjewelry.org, we consider the privacy of our visitors to be extremely important. This Privacy Policy document describes in detail the types of personal information that is collected and recorded by our website and how we use it.

Log Files

Like many other Web sites, <https://www.blackinjewelry.org> makes use of log files. These files log visitors to the Site – usually a standard procedure for hosting companies and a part of hosting services’ analytics. The information inside the log files includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date/time stamp, referring/exit pages, and possibly the number of clicks. This information is used to analyze trends, administer the site, track user’s movement around the site, and gather demographic information. IP addresses, and other such information are not linked to any information that is personally identifiable.

Cookies

This website uses cookies to store information about visitors’ preferences, to record user-specific information on which pages the Site visitor accesses or visits, and to personalize or customize

our web page content based upon visitors' browser type or other information that the visitor sends via their browser. If you wish to disable cookies, you may do so through your individual browser options. Personal information

We will collect personal information – Name, address, email and company if provided by you and store that information in your user profile to enable us to provide you with the membership services and contact you from time to time. If you subscribe to the newsletter, we will also use the information to keep you informed of our activities via newsletter. You can unsubscribe from the newsletter at any time by clicking “unsubscribe” at the bottom of any newsletter email or emailing info@blackinjewelry.org with your request.

We will not pass on your information to third parties that are not involved directly in the services we provide to you as the Black in Jewelry Coalition.

Your information may be seen, edited or deleted by you at any time and can be accessed once logged into the Site's membership page (with the exception of your user name). Website administrators can also see and edit this information.

Banking or credit card information

We may collect banking information at the time of your membership sign-up or renewal or on our sponsorship page. This information will only be used for the purpose it is entered into this Site and will not be stored on this Site.

We will not share your banking information to any third parties other than those required to execute the transactions associated with receipt of membership payments.

What rights you have over your data

If you have an account on this Site, you can request to receive an exported file of the personal data we hold about you, including any data you have provided to us. You can also request that we erase any personal data we hold about you. This does not include any data we are obliged to

keep for administrative, legal, or security purposes. We will do this within 21 days of receipt of request for deletion.

Advertising on this Site

We do not currently run third-party advertising on this Site.

Embedded content from other websites

Articles on this Site may include embedded content (e.g., videos, images, articles, etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the exact same way as if the visitor has visited the other website.
